

## powertext

"I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants" (Luke 15:18, 19).

**PRAY** Ask God to teach you how to best serve Him.

**THINK** How does the father's reaction to the son's return help you better understand God's lavish love? What are the benefits of serving God in contrast with pursuing your selfish desires?


**REVIEW** Review the power text.


PRAY Thank God for His never-ending love for you.

**REPEAT** Say your power text aloud from memory.


**PRAY** With your family, say sentence prayers, praising God for His lavish love and asking Him to help you serve others out of love.
